WORKSHOP TITLE	Chronic disorders
RATIONALE	Adolescents have special health care needs including developmentally appropriate communication in the case of chronic illness. Individuation and increasing independence during adolescence as well as expectations of increasing self-management may pose challenges in this phase of life and transitional care are a window of opportunity for improved health care
