WORKSHOP TITLE	Investing in adolescent health in the WHO European Region: how to do better
RATIONALE	<p>Whilst the WHO European region has some of the best adolescent health outcomes in the world, there is still large disparity between and within countries and some clear areas for ongoing improvement.</p> <p>This workshop provides an overview of the European adolescent health action plan, which is based on the Global Accelerated Action for the Health of Adolescents (AA-HA!), specifically adapted to the European Region, and gives an orientation on what can be done in countries. 'Investing in adolescent health in the WHO European Region: how to do better,' is an implementation guidance document for the regional context. The workshop outlines a process that can be used to develop national research programs, policy priorities, and adolescent health interventions.</p>
