<b>SYMPOSIUM TITLE</b>	<b>Juvenile Gynecology</b>
<b>RATIONALE AND CONTENT</b>	<p><b>“Hyperandrogenism and PCOS in adolescents” and “Endometriosis in adolescents”</b> Menstrual disorders with signs of hyperandrogenism and painful bleeding are very common during the adolescence. We are going to present scientific evidence-based approach and best practice in case of polycystic ovary syndrome and endometriosis in adolescents.</p> <p><b>“Evolution of hormone therapy in pediatric and adolescent gynecology.”</b> The presentation will report on current ideas about the possibilities of hormone therapy in the treatment of gynecological diseases of children and adolescents.</p> <p><b>“Experience in the management of adolescents with reproductive system disorders in eating disorders.”</b> The report presents options for hormonal correction of the menstrual cycle in different forms of eating disorders in the structure of complex management of adolescents."</p> <p><b>“Sexually transmitted infections in adolescents.”</b> Today's abundance of information about sex does not give a teenager an idea of the other side of sexual maturation — the risk of Contracting sexually transmitted infections that can cause irreparable harm to reproductive health and cause a psychological trauma for the adolescents. Effective prevention will be putt into discussion.</p> <p><b>“Gynecological problems in female infants born extremely prematurely.”</b> The survival rate of severe premature born children increased with improving of neonatal care. The aim of the report is to draw attention of gynecologists to peculiarities of gynecological problems in newborns and infants born extremely prematurely. The investigation is a new pediatric specialist area is based on the personal experience and a few available literature data. The tactics will be discussed.</p>
