<b>WORKSHOP TITLE</b>	<b>Male adolescent sexual &amp; reproductive health</b>
<b>RATIONALE</b>	<p>The stereotypes linked with masculinity have a huge impact on adolescent sexual behaviour. Too often are the decisions about having sex or choosing contraception imposed by the male partner. Paradoxically, preventive activities both on the individual and population level target most of the time adolescent girls.</p> <p>Health professionals must develop skills as how to encourage and support safe sex behaviour by male adolescents</p>
