WORKSHOP TITLE	The causes of an aggressive character: the impact of the first years of life
RATIONALE	<p>The aggressive behavior of adolescents causes them many problems of social adaptation and integration, but the neutralisation of teenage anger and adolescent violence is particularly difficult both therapeutically and institutional.</p> <p>Financial costs to combat juvenile delinquency and school bullying are also very high.</p> <p>Therefore, a good understanding of the factors that contribute in developing of an aggressive behavior in early years of life can help us avoid those harmful influences and intervene in a more competent way on children's growth and education.</p>
